

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## **BRUNO DAVID GALLERY PRESENTS A GROUP EXHIBITION BY STUDENTS OF THE ST. MICHAEL SCHOOL OF CLAYTON**

ST. LOUIS, MO (January 10, 2014) — Bruno David Gallery announces a group exhibition titled *Design, Invent, Play*, by the students of the St. Michael School of Clayton, on view January 16-18, 2014. The exhibition is organized by Charles Schwall. The opening will be **Saturday, January 18, 2014** from 4 to 6 pm.

*Design, Invent, Play*, features student work from a school-wide research project focused on the elements of design, such as graphics, fashion, product, architecture, animation, and environmental design.

The St. Michael School of Clayton (SMSOC) is an Episcopal day school for children of all faiths, age three through eighth grade. The SMSOC educational program is a balance of traditional academics and innovative research projects. The program has been shaped by many developments in education, most markedly by the school system in Reggio Emilia, Italy. The SMSOC philosophy fosters intellectual development and encourages students to explore and express themselves through multiple languages including the expressive, communicative, symbolic, cognitive, ethical, metaphorical, logical, imaginative and relational. Students also participate in long-term research projects that integrate disciplines and different areas of learning.

Through *Design, Invent, Play*, students learned about the elements of design as an integral part of the world around them. This exhibition investigates significant aspects of design, such as the invention of new ideas and concepts, the tension between aesthetics and functionality, and the unique point of view of young students.
